



Today we mark the thirty-seventh anniversary of the Anti-Tamil Pogrom of July 1983. Thousands of Tamils were massacred by Sinhala mobs backed by elements within the Sri Lankan government and state forces.

The United States Tamil Action Group (USTAG) unequivocally condemns the actions of the President of Sri Lanka who is initiating "an informal Military takeover" of the civilian administration of the country by militarizing the COVID-19 response, and ruling by presidential decrees through creating an all-military task force while parliament remains dissolved. We call upon the international community of nations to arrest the careening of the country into a dictatorship.

We sent out a joint statement release to member states to open discussion on Sri Lanka at the 44th UNHRC session.


